

Poppy's Best Puppets

YOU WILL NEED

- * Socks- solids or patterns
- * Glue tacky glue, or fabric glue
- * felt tip pen
- * Scissors
- * Eyes can be buttons, pompoms, sequins, rhinestones, sticky-back googly eyes
- * Accessories doll hats, yarn for hair, felt or construction paper for tongue, horns, bows, or whatever you like!

Slip the sock over your hand.

Make a C shape with your hand and try to put your thumb in the heel part with your fingers in the toe of the sock.

Open & close your hand and decide where you want the eyes and nose.


Use your marker to make 2 dots for the eyes. (above the seam of the sock)

Mark the nose.

Take off the sock and lay it flat on the table. The marks may look out of place, but that is why you marked it on your hand!

Glue on eyes & nose where you've marked. Cut hair, tongue, hat, or whatever from yarn, felt or construction paper. Stick to your new puppet friend!

* Use a pencil to make a small hole about two inches from one end of the cardboard tube.

*sharpened pencil

* Cut a square of waxed paper that's about an inch or two wider than the end of the tube.

* Wrap the waxed paper tightly over the end of the tube where you made the hole. Hold it in place with a rubber band. (Make sure you don't cover the hole you made.)Trim off any excess waxed paper with scissors.

Poppy's Crispy Monster Treats

- 1/4 c. unsweetened cocoa
- 2 T. water
- 1/4 c. peanut butter
- 2 large tablespoons Marshmallow Fluff
- 3/4 c. bran flakes cereal
- Pretzel sticks for spines
- Round candies for eyes
- 1 c. shredded coconut



Blend cocoa with water. Stir in peanut butter (mixture will be thick). Add Fluff. Stir until thoroughly blended. Add bran, and half of coconut. Form into 1-inch balls. Roll in remaining coconut. Stick in pretzel sticks for spines and round candies for

eyes! Let stand 1 hour. Makes 2 1/2 dozen.

Poppy's Best Bookmarks


You will need:


- Paper

- 5. Your bookmarks are ready to be used!














Poppy's Best Garland


You will need:


- Paper
